The reason given by Health Canada for the cease installation order is that the product is not permitted to be used in Canada by a law that was passed in 1979.

This law was created in response to a very different product.

What RetroFoam of Canada knows is:

- A) The product is safe.
- B) This product is being utilized on an ongoing basis internationally and the rate of installations are rapidly rising.
- C) The insulation is stable and does not de-generate or lose its performance over time.
- D) Third party in home testing has verified that this product satisfies Health Canada's Exposure Guidelines for Indoor Air Quality, which are among the most stringent in the world today.

This product is completely different in its essential formulation, chemical reaction and performance than the product that led to the passing of the 1979 law.

Other industrialized countries have recognized this difference and have rescinded their prohibitions on insulation products with this essential base chemistry. To our knowledge Canada is the only industrialized nation that has not rescinded their 30 year old prohibitions.

RetroFoam of Canada is confident that any testing efforts made by Health Canada will confirm that customers who have used our product in their homes have a safe and beneficial insulation that saves them money.
