

Effective April 1, 2010, the federal government pulled out of providing grants to new applicants to the popular and effective ecoENERGY Retrofit - Homes energy efficiency homeowner grant program, without warning or consultation. ecoENERGY grants from the federal government will not be provided to homeowners who are not currently registered within the program. Those homeowners who have already had an initial audit under the ecoENERGY program will still be able to take advantage of both federal and provincial grants by having a follow-up home evaluation (an "E" visit), if they have not already, no later than March 2011 (assuming they are still within their 18-month period and, if not, assuming they extended their time). Please be aware that, if homeowners did not register for a second follow-up home evaluation (known as an "F" visit) before April 1, 2010, the "F" visit option is no longer available to these homeowners.
